 - Year 2 last year - District selected 2 focus areas, Responsive Culture & Relationships & as a building how it will tie into our school improvement plan. District selected Chair and members for our OVT.
 - Year 3 this year – District has started planning for year 3. The district will be implementing a district-wide MTSS program.

 - Test Scores-AT DCMS, we are constantly striving to collect data that moves our students forward. We give the state mandated Predictive Assessments three times a year to assess where students might perform on the state assessments. This helps to identify any student's gaps and assists the teachers in lesson planning and individual student differentiation. We also give reading and math inventories three times a year for the same purpose....data collecting to identify student needs. The state assessments are just one piece of the student profile – a specific test given on a specific day.
 - MTSS Student Interventions & DCMS Intervention Plan
 - Indicator #3411: The school implements a reliable and valid system-wide screening process (Kansas MTSS) for academics and behavior that includes the assessment of all students,

multiple times per year and establishes decision rules to determine those students in need of targeted intervention.
