PROGRESS REPORT INDIVIDUAL PLANS OF STUDY

- Portfolios are personalized reflections of individual's accomplishments and will look different based on grade level expectations to include a students' interest.
 - For example, the art class created birthday cards to send out to Fort Dodge. This experience would be tagged as a community service project for the art class.
- Methods for Individual Student Goals for all grade levels have been established.
- Ties between Career Cruiser and Individual plans of study are under review for advisory activity structures.
- In-service has been completed on Career Cruising information access and all advisory teachers are aware of the importance for reviewing data when appropriate.
- GoEnnounce is a reflection tool for Career Cruiser and will be included based on grade level decisions.
- Career Cruising activity guides have been distributed to all team leaders for the purpose of designing when appropriate advisory activities.
- GoEnnounce universal tags are being developed by Connect teachers as a classification sorting tool stipulated under the AR2 rubrics.
- Foundational questions are being reviewed by each grade level to determine activities and procedures to follow by each grade.
