

Dodge City Public Schools- Summer School 2020 Information

This year, all students have taken FastBridge assessments. Based on the data/results for the fall and winter assessments; your student is recommended/highly recommended to attend summer school.

The purpose of summer school is to provide targeted enrichment for students identified through the collection of individual performance/ readiness data through Fastbridge. The intent is to reduce summer slide and provide time to focus on literacy and math skill development and/or enrichment. In addition, it is encouraged that the instruction incorporates experiential learning opportunities through activities such as, but not limited to, project based learning, hands on learning, culturally connected activities, and educational trips that extend the relevancy of the specific content standards.

Elementary Level: (Kinder through Fifth Grade)

We will be having two sessions.

- One session will be from June 1st through June 12th
- Second session will be July 27th through August 7th
- Breakfast will be from 7:30 to 8:00
- Instructional time will be from 8:00 to 11:30
- Lunch will be from 11:30 to 12:00

Middle School Level: (Sixth through Eighth Grade)

- FastBridge Data Driven (aReading: High Risk- highly recommended; Some Risk-recommended)
- We will be offering one session
- Session will be from June 1st through June 25th
- Monday through Thursday
- June 12th and June 25th may be dates for educational trips
- Breakfast will be from 7:30 to 8:00
- Instructional time will be from 8:00 to 11:30
- Lunch will be from 11:30 to 12:00

High School Level: (Ninth through Twelfth)

- We will be offering one session
- One session will be from June 1st through June 26th
- Session is from 8:00 to 2:30
- Credit Recovery focus
