FOUR CORNERS

An approach that asks students to form an opinion.

AOTON

STEPS:

- 1. Give students a prompt that requires them to form an opinion about the prompt. Use Likert scale options such as Strongly Agree, Agree, Disagree and Strongly Disagree.
- Post the response options in four 'corners of the room. Students walk to the area where their Likert scale choice is posted.
 In their groups, students discuss their reasons for choosing the option they did. Each group then reports out to the class. As a follower the teacher was an an area was an area was an area and area and an area area and an area and an area and an area area and an area and an area area and area area.
 - follow-up, the teacher can ask students to go to another corner and argue the prompt from that point of view.
