- Wednesday: Grade Level PLC's Expectations

Title I After School Program (Needs Conversation & Adjustments) See Section V.(A)

- Teachers will be paid at \$29.69 and teams will need to identify after school grade level teachers.
- The after school math and reading seminar is held from 3:20 – 4:20 P.M. Monday through Thursday and provides re-teaching opportunities in both a 30 minute session in math and a 30 minute session in reading.
- Students are identified by their performance on state achievement test. Students who score between 199 and 299 on their state math and reading assessments will be re-taught units of study they are currently receiving during regular instruction.
- Students will receive 16 days of re-teaching opportunities and will be reassessed through formative process at the end of the 16th day session in both math and reading. Students will also be considered for these classes when SMI and SRI scores fall below proficient.
- Teams need to identify students who qualify during kid days/grade level PLC's
- Need a Confirmed List by Friday September 9 by Grade Level
- Start Date for After School Program September 12

Advisory Five Day Cycle Schedule 2.06

- Monday & Tuesday: Building 21st Century Skills Portfolios
 - Hold yourselves accountable for engaging enrichment activities during advisory.
 - Develop additional resources for student portfolios'
 - What artifact selections give important evidence to demonstrate grade level expectations for student growth?
 - How will you use advisory time?
 - What resources will you need?
 - How will you reflect its effectiveness in achieving results?
 - Grade level principals will monitor effectiveness.
- Wednesday: Missing Assignment Return Day
 - Each team has developed accountability standards for missing assignments that will be communicated to parents at the first of each school year.
 - All missing assignments, including homework, will be recorded as missing in Skyward. Missing work will be accepted with the following conditions:
 - If a student is missing three (3) assignments for any one subject the advisory teacher will make contact with the parent/guardian by the preferred method of communication.
 - Wednesday will be the day that work will be returned for missing assignments.

 - Missing assignments will be printed and handed out to students every Friday during advisory class. The sixth grade requires teacher signature for completion of missing assignments.
